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

Shella Royal House is located in the idyllic fishing village of Shella, on tranquil Lamu Island. With no vehicles, the island exists as it has for centuries with donkeys and dhow sailing boats being the main form of transport. A stay on Lamu is simply the essence of total relaxation.

Shella Royal House consists of 2 traditional Swahili guesthouses, offering a total of 10 guest rooms and 3 penthouses with exceptional rooftop terraces, overlooking Manda Channel. With a gourmet chef on-site specialising in Swahili dishes, you will dine on a variety of seafood dishes, with produce delivered fresh from the ocean. Dining on the open-air, rooftop terrace overlooking a beautiful stretch of sandy beach and listening to the sounds of the village, is an experience to treasure. Relax on spotless sandy beaches, enjoy sundowners on a dhow sunset sail or visit Lamu Old Town on a walking tour. Shella also has its own modern fishing boat, ideal for deep-sea fishing excursions. After you fish some of the finest waters in Africa, you can return to cook your catch on the deck, served with an accompanying glass of wine and a mesmerising Lamu sunset.



Muru National Park is fast regaining its reputation as one of Kenya's premier tourism destinations, as it was back in the days when renowned conservationists Joy & George Adamson resided here with Elsa the Lion, of 'Born Free' fame.

Murera Springs Eco Lodge, right by the entrance to the park, offers a piece of paradise at an affordable price. Murera Springs has 10 comfortable, ensuite cabins each with its own secluded verandah overlooking lush gardens teeming with birdlife. The lodge is powered by solar energy and is constructed using recycled materials, minimising its impact on the surrounding environs. It focuses on seasonal produce and community empowerment, with all fruit and vegetables sourced from nearby farms.

After game drives in Muru National Park and its adjacent rhino sanctuary, guests can take a refreshing dip in the swimming pool under a majestic canopy of trees and later recount the day's adventures around the evening camp fire.



Maili Saba Camp is a sanctuary of tranquillity, perched on the edge of the magnificent Menengai Crater near Lake Nakuru National Park. The hallmark of this intimate camp is its focus on warm African hospitality and its excellent service, whilst maintaining a casual, welcoming atmosphere. JK MARA CAMP

Set amongst the picturesque African plains of the 1800 acre Muliban Conservancy, adjacent to the Talek River in Masai Mara, is JK Mara Camp. The camp features 14 permanent tents with full ensuite, as well as a comfortable bar and lounge with small library. As the sun sets, the campfire is lit and stories of the African bush are shared between the Masai staff and guests, well into the evening.
